## Statement of Senator Jim Webb on his Endorsement of Leslie Byrne for U.S. Congress

Washington, DC—Senator Jim Webb (D-VA) today issued the following statement:

"I am pleased to announce that I am endorsing the candidacy of Leslie Byrne for Congress from Virginia's 11<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.

"I am convinced that Leslie Byrne is our best candidate. Leslie shares my values about economic fairness and the need to re-order our national security policies – both in Iraq and throughout the world. In her service as a state legislator and member of Congress, Leslie Byrne has demonstrated time and again that she is tough, fiercely independent and willing to stand up to powerful special interests.
